

Conditions of Play
PIMD 2 bowl Mixed Triple Triples

Mixed triples teams will play two 14 end games, one before lunch, one in the afternoon.

Trial ends for the first game only.

To start the **am** game, the **lead** whose next birthday is closest to today goes first. The next closest goes second. The remaining lead plays third.

The team vices and skips use that same rotation for delivering their bowls.

For the **pm** game, use the **vices'** next birthdays.

Play proceeds as in our usual games, leads play, vices play, switch and skips play. Easy, right???

Scoring: 3 points for the closest bowl.
 2 points for the next closest bowl.
 1 point for the 3rd closest bowl

This is a new format and timing is an unknown.

Please do not make frivolous measures and use up precious bowling time.

* In the unlikely event of a tie for the #1 shot, each team receives 2.5 points (#1+#2 divided). Next closest bowl gets 1 point. Same process for tie of 2nd and 3rd shots, each team receiving 1.5 points.

Vices, signal your skips properly and clearly. Skips, check that end points add up to 6.

PLEASE check that scorecard point totals match at every end.

At the end of the game, total points scored for 3 teams should add up to 84.

The team lead with the 3-point bowl sets the mat and delivers the jack to begin the next end. The team lead with the 2-point bowl follows. If that is the same team which earned the 3 points, the 1-point bowl goes next, and the remaining player bowls last. **IF** one team earns all 6 points, that team begins the next end and remaining players follow the same rotation as the end just completed. Vices and skips will need to be fully aware of the rotation when it is their turn to bowl.

Jacks knocked out of bounds will be respotted centered on the 2-meter line.

The winning skip must collect and turn in all 3 scorecards to the tournament director's table upon completion of the game.

Umpires today are _____ and all are playing. Skips should do close measures before calling for an umpire.

To make our green is as COVID safe as possible, only leads near the mat when they are bowling. Only vices near the mat when it is their turn. Only vices near the head when skips are bowling and when measuring.
